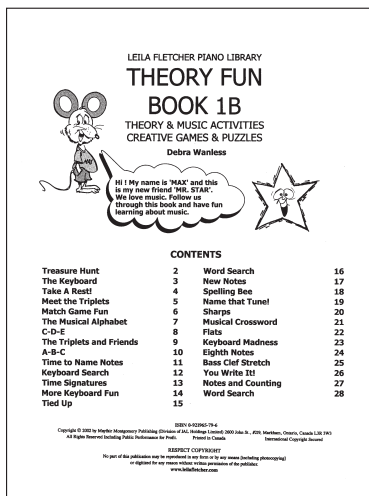

Tied Up
